Short term E-Tender is invited for supply of 200 qtls.Turmeric Fingers at Hafed Turmeric Plant, Radaur (Yamuna Nagar) as per Specifications mentioned in the tender document in single stage two cover system i.e. request for Pre-Qualification/Technical Bid (online bid under PQQ/Technical Envelope) and request for Financial Bid (comprising of price bid Proposal under online available Commercial Envelope)

Under this process, the Pre-qualification/Technical Bid Application as well as online Price Bid shall be invited at single stage under two cover i.e. PQQ/Technical Bid & Commercial Envelope. Eligibility of the Bidders will be first examined based on the details submitted online under first cover (PQQ or Technical) with the request to eligibility and qualification criteria prescribed in the Tender document. The Price Bid under the second cover shall be opened for only those bidders whose PQQ/Technical Applications are responsive to eligibility and qualifications requirements as per Tender document.

INSTRUCTIONS TO PARTY/BIDDER ON ELECTRONIC TENDERING SYSTEM

These conditions will over-rule the conditions stated in the tender documents, wherever relevant and applicable.

1. Registration of bidders on e-Procurement Portal:-

All the parties/bidders intending to participate in the tender's process online are required to get registered on the centralized e-Procurement Portal i.e. **https://etenders.hry.nic.in**. Please visit the website for more details.

2. <u>Obtaining a Digital Certificate:</u>

- 2.1 The Bids submitted online should be encrypted and signed electronically with a Digital Certificate to establish the identity of the party/bidder bidding online. These Digital Certificates are issued by an Approved Certifying Authority, by the Controller of Certifying Authorities, Government of India.
- 2.2 A Digital Certificate is issued upon receipt of mandatory identity (i.e. Applicant's PAN Card) and Address proofs and verification form duly attested by the Bank Manager / Postmaster /Gazetted Officer. Only upon the receipt of the required documents, a digital certificate can be issued. For more details please visit the website <u>https://etenders.hry.nic.in</u>.
- **2.3** The parties/bidders may obtain Class-II or III digital signature certificate from any Certifying Authority or Sub-certifying Authority authorized by the Controller of Certifying Authorities or may obtain information and application format and documents required for the issue of digital certificate from.
- 2.4 The party/bidder must ensure that he/she comply by the online available important guidelines at the portal https:// etenders.hry.nic.in for Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) including the e-Token carrying DSCs.



- 2.5 Bid for a particular tender must be submitted online using the digital certificate (Encryption & Signing), which is used to encrypt and sign the data during the stage of bid preparation. In case, during the process of a particular tender, the user loses his digital certificate (due to virus attack, hardware problem, operating system or any other problem) he will not be able to submit the bid online. Hence, the users are advised **to keep a backup of the certificate** and also keep the copies at safe place under proper security (for its use in case of emergencies).
- 2.6 In case of online tendering, if the digital certificate issued to the authorized user of a firm is used for signing and submitting a bid, it will be considered equivalent to a no-objection certificate/power of attorney /lawful authorization to that User. The firm has to authorize a specific individual through an authorization certificate signed by all partners to use the digital certificate as per Indian Information Technology Act 2000. Unless the certificates are revoked, it will be assumed to represent adequate authority of the user to bid on behalf of the firm in the department tenders as per Information Technology Act 2000. The digital signature of this authorized user will be binding on the firm.
- 2.7 In case of any change in the authorization, it shall be the responsibility of management / partners of the firm to inform the certifying authority about the change and to obtain the digital signatures of the new person / user on behalf of the firm / company. The procedure for application of a digital certificate however will remain the same for the new user.
- **2.8** The same procedure holds true for the authorized users in a private/Public limited company. In this case, the authorization certificate will have to be signed by the directors of the company.

3. Opening of an Electronic Payment Account:

For purchasing the tender documents online, parties/bidders are required to pay the tender documents fees online using the electronic payments gateway service shall be integrated with the system very soon till then it will be submitted manually. 7.1 <u>Online Payment of Tender Document Fee + e-Service fee:</u>

The secure electronic payments gateway is an online interface between contractors and Debit card / online payment authorization networks.

In the first instance, the online payment details of tender document fee + e-Service and EMD & PQQ/Technical Envelope shall be opened. Henceforth, financial bid quoted against each of the item by the shortlisted bidder/party/Agency wherever required shall be opened online in the presence of such parties/bidders/Agency who either themselves or through their representatives choose to be present.

The bidder can submit online their bids as per the dates mentioned in the schedule/Key Dates above.

Guideline for Online Payments at e-Procurement Portal of Government of Haryana.

Post registration, Party/bidder shall proceed for bidding by using both his digital certificates (one each for encryption and signing) & Password. Bidder/Party shall proceed to select the event/Tenders he is interested in. On the respective Department's page in the e-Procurement portal, the Bidder would have following options to make payment for tender document fee & EMD:

- A. Debit Card
- B. Net Banking
- C. RTGS/NEFT

Operative Procedures for Bidder Payments

A) Debit Card

The procedure for paying through Debit Card will be as follows:

- (i) Bidder selects Debit Card option in e-Procurement portal.
- (ii) The e-Procurement portal displays the amount and the card charges to be paid by bidder. The portal also displays the total amount to be paid by the bidder.
- (iii) Bidder clicks on "Continue" button
- (iv) The e-Procurement portal takes the bidder to Debit Card payment gateway screen.
- (v) Bidder enters card credentials and confirms payment
- (vi) The gateway verifies the credentials and confirms with "successful" or "failure" message, which is confirmed back to e-Procurement portal. The page is automatically routed back to e-Procurement portal.
- (vii) The status of the payment is displayed as "successful" in e-Procurement portal. The e- Procurement portal also generates a receipt for all successful transactions. The bidder can take a printout of the same,
- (viii) The e-Procurement portal allows Bidder to process another payment attempt in case payments are not successful for previous attempt.



B) Net Banking

The procedure for paying through Net Banking will be as follows:

- (i) Bidder selects Net Banking option in e-Procurement portal.
- (ii) The e-Procurement portal displays the amount to be paid by bidder.
- (iii) Bidder clicks on "Continue" button
- (iv) The e-Procurement portal takes the bidder to Net Banking payment gateway screen displaying list of Banks
- (v) Bidder chooses his / her Bank
- (vi) The Net Banking gateway redirects Bidder to the Net Banking page of the selected Bank
- (vii) Bidder enters his account credentials and confirms payment
- (viii) The Bank verifies the credentials and confirms with "successful" or "failure" message to the Net Banking gateway which is confirmed back to e-Procurement portal.
- (ix) The page is automatically routed back to e-Procurement portal
- (x) The status of the payment is displayed as "successful" in e-Procurement portal. The e-Procurement portal also generates a receipt for all successful transactions. The bidder can take a print out of the same.
- (xi) In case of successful payment, a success message along with unique transaction ID is passed on to e-Procurement system. The e-Procurement portal shall store the unique transaction number in its database along with the date and timestamp.
- (xii) The e-Procurement portal allows Bidder to process another payment attempt in case payments are not successful for previous attempt.

C) RTGS/ NEFT/OTC

The bidder shall have the option to make the EMD payment via RTGS/ NEFT/OTC. Using this module, bidder would be able to pay from their existing Bank account through RTGS/NEFT. This would offer a wide reach for more than 1,10,000 bank branches and would enable the bidder to make the payment from almost any bank branch across India.

- 1. To choose the payment of EMD, the bidder clicks on RTGS/NEFT payment option.
- 2. Upon doing so, the e-Procurement portal will redirect the bidder to a page where it will generate a Challan.

3. This Challan shall include the beneficiary (virtual) account number and other deta

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RTGS / NEFT Payment Procedure

The bidder shall be required to take a print of the challan and make the RTGS / NEFT on the basis of the virtual account number period on the challan. This provision will ensure that number confidential details regarding the bidder or tender are disclosed to the bank while remitting the RTGS/NEFT.

The bidder would remit the fund at least one day in advance to the last day and make the payment via RTGS/NEFT to the beneficiary account number as mention in the challan. SBI Bank shall receive this amount and credit the payment gateway service provider intermediary Department/PSUs Escrow Security Deposit account post validating the first part of the beneficiary account number, i.e., the client code only, In case of validation of client code is not successful, the bank shall return the fund and not credit the Tech process intermediary Department/PSUs Escrow Security Deposit A/c.

Over The Counter (OTC)

This solution shall allow the bidder having account with SBI bank, to make the payment from any CMS enables Branch of SBI Bank in India. Bidders can make the payment via cash (if amount is <=[]49,999), Demand Draft or SBI Bank Cheque.

The procedure for paying through OTC mode is as follows:

- (i) Bidder selects over the counter remittance option in e-Procurement portal.
- (ii) The e-Procurement portal displays the amount to be paid. The bidder chooses the bank account number for refund of the amount.
- (iii) Bidder clicks on "Continue" Button.
- (iv) The e-Procurement portal displays the details of payment. The Bidders click on "Print_Challan" and print the OTC Challan.
- (v) Bidder submits the OTC Challan at the counter of any designated bank of SBI Bank with Cash/Demand Draft/SBI Bank Cheque (Payment in Cash is allowed upto Rs. 49,999/-).
- (vi) SBI bank verifies the URL (format to be discussed and decided) and amount with e-10 | P a g e

Procurement portal prior to accepting the payment.



- (vii) On successful verification from e-Procurement portal, SBI bank accepts the payment. In case of failure, SBI bank shall return back the OTC challan and payment to the bidder.
- (viii) SBI bank commits the payment transaction (in case of successful verification from e-Procurement portal) and sends the Bank Transaction number (I- Sure Reference Number) online against the URN and Amount.
- (ix) SBI bank will generate receipt for the payment transaction and issues the same to the bidder.
- (x) The e-Procurement system update the bank transaction number against the URN and Amount based on the details sent by SBI bank online prior to generation of the receipt.
- (xi) The status of the payment will be displayed as "verification successful" in e- Procurement Portal, when the bidder clicks on the verification option in the portal.
- (xii) Bidder would be required to upload the scan copy of receipt as received from SBI Bank as part of proof in next tender portal before submitting the tender.



Introduction:

HAFED is the largest apex cooperative federation of Haryana State in India. It came into existence on November 1st, 1966 with the formation of Haryana as a separate State. Since then, it is playing a leading role in serving the farmers of the State as well as customers in India and overseas by providing hygienic and safe quality consumer products.

HAFED is running a Turmeric/ Spices Processing plant at Radaur, District Yamuna Nagar (Haryana) having 3 TPD turmeric processing capacity and 2 TPD of multi spices processing capacity. For running of this Processing Plant, Hafed has to purchase Turmeric Fingers as per the specifications given in the tender document, from the Traders/FPOs/Societies/ firms/etc. meeting the minimum eligibility criteria for supply of Turmeric fingers through e-tender.

1. General Information:

i. The technical as well as financial bid is to be submitted online on the web portal https://etenders.hry.nic.in. However, the firms have the option to submit the supporting documents as required to be supported along with the technical bid either through the online mode along with the technical bids or in the off line mode in physical form to the Hafed Corporate Office, Sector-5, Panchkula by the due date/time. In case the supporting documents are to be submitted off line in physical form, then it should be specified in their technical bids and the supporting documents must be deposited before the due date and time of opening of technical bids. Bidders will have to procure/should have a legally valid digital signature certificate as per the Information Technology Act 2000, using which they can sign their online bids. Documents for the technical bid and the financial bid shall be submitted separately as per details given below.

ii. Technical bid for supply of Turmeric fingers.

The Performa of technical bid is enclosed at Annexure-I.

iii. Specifications for supply of Turmeric fingers at Annexure-II

iv. FINANCIAL BID:

- **a.** First of all technical bids of the bidders will be opened.
- b. The bidders who are found technically qualified will have to submit the sealed samples of Turmeric fingers (2 No. Samples of the same quality, at least 500 gm each) along with test report from NABL approved Lab in the processing division, Hafed Corporate Office, Sector- 5 Panchkula before opening of the financial bid.



- **c.** The committee of Hafed will physically inspect the samples and only those bidders will be considered for opening of financial bids by the committee of Hafed whose samples are found healthy/superior quality and as per Hafed Specification on the bases of Lab report submitted by the bidder.
- d. The rates are to be quoted in financial bids. The Performa for the financial bid is enclosed at Annexure-III. Financial bid of only technically qualified bidders and who have submitted the samples as per Hafed specification will be opened.
- v. The tentative tendered quantity of Turmeric fingers enclosed at Annexure-IV.
- vi. The tentative quantity can be decreased or increased by Hafed.
- vii. Tender offer should be valid for a period of 30 days from opening of the financial bid.

e. Eligible Criteria:

The eligibility criteria for submission of Tender for supply of Turmeric Fingers is as under:

- i. The bidder should be a trader/FPO/Society/Firm/etc..
- ii. Should have valid GST registration certificate.
- iii. Should have valid PAN card and bank account.
- iv. Bidder must not be blacklisted by any Central/ State Department / organization in last 5 years.

f. TENDER TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

- i. Bids without EMD deposit of Rs.25000/- proof shall be rejected straight way.
- ii. The EMD of the successful bidder shall be refunded only after successful execution of the contract.
- iii. If the bidder(s) previously held any contract and furnished security/ earnest money with Hafed that security/earnest money deposit shall not be adjusted against EMD of this tender and a fresh EMD shall be required to be furnished.
- iv. The successful bidder(s) shall have to deposit 2% security amount (including EMD) of the equal amount of supply order within 3 bank working days from the date of issuance of supply order by Hafed, by means of RTGS / NEFT/ Bank draft in Hafed Turmeric Plant, Radaur Bank Account, failing which EMD shall be forfeited. The security amount shall be deposited for the supply period only, till the material is supplied at Hafed Turmeric Processing Plant Radaur and the same shall be released to the supplier after receipt of the material at Hafed Turmeric Processing Plant, Radaur and satisfactory Lab analyses report

as per specifications after its sampling by Hafed. However, no interest whatsoever shall bearing by Hafed.

- v. The supply order will be issued to the bidder whose rates are lowest and have submitted healthy samples of Turmeric fingers in visual appearing besides consideration of the quality parameters as per lab (NABL approved) report submitted by the bidder.
- vi. The negotiation will be held as per Haryana Govt. instructions/rules.
- vii. Rate of the Turmeric fingers will be F.O.R. at Hafed Turmeric Plant, Radaur (Yamuna Nagar), Haryana inclusive of GST, mandi cess and or all Taxes/Govt. levies, etc. In case, Govt. increases/decreases the GST during pendency of the contract, similar effect will be made on the rates quoted by the supplier. In case of tax exempted units, they shall provide valid tax exemption certification from the concerned authorities well in time.

viii. Delivery Period:-

The successful bidder will have to supply the material within 25 days of issuance of supply order. For delayed supply, penalty @ 2% per week or part thereof shall be imposed subject to maximum of 5%, failing which Hafed have the liberty to make purchases from any other source at the risk and cost of the party.

ix. Payment Terms:-

70% payment will be released after receipt of material at Hafed godown Radaur and on the basis of visual inspection of the material as per sample already submitted by the bidder and Lab (NABL approved) test report results provided by the supplier, if it is as per required specifications. Balance 30% payment will be released on the satisfactory lab analysis report through Hafed internal lab/outside lab (NABL/BIS approved) by lot wise sampling of the material supplied within 20 days of receipt of the material.

The material found below specifications / improper packaging, not cleaned/ graded will be notified to the party and will have to be lifted back and will have to be replaced immediately at his risk and cost. Payment of that "below specification" supplies will be with held till its receipt as per specification, the supplier will be responsible to lift the material back at his expenses.

In case party is not satisfied with the result of Hafed internal lab /outside lab report then only after written request of the party within 3 days of receipt of the lab report, referee sample will be sent to another BIS/NABL approved lab and average of two nearest labs results will be taken as reference and that will be acceptable to supplier and Hafed. The cost payment of sample test will be deducted from the supplier's bill.

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g. Transit Risk

The bidder is bound to send the materials at Hafed Turmeric Plant, Radaur (Yamuna Nagar), as stated in the Supply/ Work order issued to the bidder/firms at his own risk and cost. The transportation cost, transits risk, insurance etc. are to be borne by bidder.

h. Foreclosure

Hafed reserves the right to foreclose the contract without assigning any reason. In such case the bidder will not be entitled to any compensation for non-supply or loss/ profit or any incidental costs of any kind.

6. Force majeure:

In case of occurrence of any of the force majeure circumstances, namely act of God, natural calamity, fire, Govt. of India Policy/restriction (excluding any stock limits), strikes or lockouts by workmen, war, military operations of any nature and blockage preventing the seller/buyer or the exchange from wholly or partially carrying out their contractual obligation, the period stipulated for the performance of the contract shall be extended in the event of the circumstances continuing for more than 15 days, either party shall have the right to refuse to fulfill contractual obligation without title to indemnification of any losses, it may the re-by sustain. The party unable to carry out its contractual obligation shall immediately advise the other party of the commencement or termination of the circumstances preventing the performance of contract."

7. Arbitration

i. If any dispute of difference of any king whatsoever shall arise between the parties in connection with or arising out of this agreement (and whether before or after the termination on breach of this agreement) parties shall promptly and in good faith negotiate with a view to arrive at amicable resolution and settlement. In the event no amicable resolution and settlement is reached within a period of 15 days from the date on which the dispute or difference arose, such dispute of differences shall be referred to a mutually acceptable sole Arbitrator, or upon the failure of the parties to agree upon a sole Arbitrator, either party may get the appointment of Sole Arbitrator from the competent court of governing jurisdiction. The Arbitration proceedings shall be conducted as per the provision of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act and rules

made there under. The fees and expenses shall be borne equally by both the partie

ii. The existence of any dispute of differences or the initiation or continuation of the arbitration proceeding shall not postpone or delay the performance by the parties of their respective obligation pursuant to this agreement. The outcome of the Arbitration shall be binding upon all the parties involved."

Annexure- II

Standards for Procurement of Dry Turmeric Rhizomes/ Fingers for Essential Oil Extraction through Steam Distillation

Turmeric fingers (whole Haldi) intended for essential oil extraction shall be processed by curing, which involves soaking the rhizomes in boiling water followed by drying to prevent regeneration. The rhizomes should be either in their natural state or machine polished. The product must possess the characteristic odor and flavor of turmeric, free from mustiness or any other foreign odors. It should be free from mold, living and dead insects, insect fragments, and rodent contamination. Additionally, the product must not contain lead chromate, added starch, or any extraneous coloring matter.

The turmeric fingers shall conform to the following standards, in compliance with FSSAI (Food Safety and Standards Authority of India) specifications:

- 1. Extraneous Matter: Not more than 1.0% by weight.
- 2. Defective Rhizomes: Not more than 5.0% by weight.
 - *Explanation*: Defective rhizomes include shriveled fingers, internally damaged rhizomes, hollow or porous rhizomes, those scorched by boiling, and other types of damaged rhizomes.
- 3. Moisture Content: Not more than 12.0% by weight.
- 4. Insect-Damaged Matter: Not more than 1.0% by weight.
- 5. Test for Lead Chromate: Must be negative.
- 6. Essential (Volatile) Oil Content: More than 4% by weight.
- 7. Curcumin Content: More than 5% by weight.
- 8. Presence of Ethylene Oxide (ETO): Maximum limit of 0.1 mg/kg.
- 9. Metal Contaminants: Levels must comply with FSSAI standards for the following metals:
 - \circ Lead
 - Copper
 - Arsenic
 - \circ Tin
 - \circ Cadmium
 - Mercury
- 10. Microbiological Parameters: Must comply with FSSAI standards for:
 - Aerobic Plate Count
 - Yeast and Mold Count
 - Enterobacteriaceae
 - Staphylococcus aureus
 - o Salmonella spp.
 - o Sulphite-Reducing Clostridia
 - Bacillus cereus



Additional Notes:

- **Quality Assurance**: Suppliers are required to ensure that the turmeric rhizomes meet all the specified standards. Regular testing should be conducted using methods approved by FSSAI or accredited laboratories.
- **Packaging and Storage**: The product should be packed in clean, dry, and airtight sacks to prevent contamination and moisture ingress. Storage areas should be clean, dry, and protected from pests.

Note : The procurement of dry turmeric rhizomes/fingers as high-quality raw materials suitable for essential oil extraction through steam distillation.
